325. Estate of Jacob Stubing, dec.  
Carl Wickro, Administrator.

In this cause the Adm. appeared in Court pursuant to a citation and presented his final account with said Estate duly sworn to, showing a balance of \$ 32.10 in the hands of the Adm. as the only property belonging to said Estate.

The Court approved said acct. & Exhibit for record.

Upon the statement of the Adm. that the only descendants of the dec. are his two sons Jacob Stubing, now of age, and Friedrich Stubing about 16 years old, that both of them have been supported & maintained for a long time by the Widow of the dec. and upon evidence, that never an allowance has been set out to said Widow & Children,

The Court ordered, that the above amount of \$ 32.10. shall be set out & allowed to said Widow, and that, as there remains nothing of the Estate in the hands of the Adm. after the delivery of the said sum to the Widow of the dec., the Adm. after paying costs of Court and filing the receipt for \$ 32.10 from the Widow with the C. Clerk, shall be discharged from said Administration.
